

NYSMLA "FIFTY" AWARD PROGRAM

The OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS HEREBY ESTABLISH THE FOLLOWING PROGRAM. IT IS OUR PLEASURE TO HONOR THOSE SHOOTERS WHO HAVE DISTINGUISHED THEMSELVES IN MUZZLE LOADING **RIFLE, SMOOTHBORE, PISTOL, AND METALLIC CARTRIDGE COMPETITION** BY SHOOTING SCORES OF "**FIFTY**". SUCH ACCOMPLISHMENTS WILL BE REWARDED WITH A DISTINCTIVE PIN AND CERTIFICATE. THOSE OF SUCH ACHIEVEMENT WILL APPEAR IN THE "G.T"

RIFLE – CONDITIONS OF AWARD:

- 1) The club will be an affiliated club of the NYSMLA.
- 2) The score of fifty will be shot using a muzzle loading rifle with iron sites. Therefore no telescopic or similar sights and shot in the off-hand position as described by the National Muzzle Loading Rifle Association.
- 3) A patched ball will be the projectile of choice.
- 4) The following targets will be shot in Affiliated Clubs or NYSMLA matches advertised in the "*Group Tightner*" and open to any qualified person.
- 5) The twenty-five yard target will be the standard "six bull" @ 2 7/8 inch.
- 6) The fifty yard target will be the standard 100 yard target "YD-1" @ 6 inch.
- 7) The one hundred yard target will be the standard "200 yards-1@12 inches.

PISTOL – CONDITIONS OF AWARD

- 1) The club will be an affiliated club of the NYSMLA.
- 2) The score of fifty will be shot using a muzzle loading pistol with iron sites, as defined by the NMLRA. Will be shot in the off-hand and one handed position as described by the National ML Rifle Association.
- 3) A patched ball will be the projectile of choice.
- 4) The following targets will be shot in Affiliated Clubs or NYSMLA matches advertised in the "*Group Tightner*" and open to any qualified person.
- 5) The twenty-five yard target will be the standard B17, 5 shot match only.

SMOOTHBORE – CONDITIONS OF AWARD

- 1) The club will be an affiliated club of the NYSMLA.
 - 2) The score of fifty will be shot using a muzzle loading smoothbore with iron sites as defined by the NMLRA. Therefor no rear sight above the plain of the barrel, 28 GA or larger, no set triggers and flintlock ignition and shot off-hand position as describe by the NMLRA.
 - 3) A patched ball will be the projectile of choice.
 - 4) The following targets will be shot in Affiliated Clubs or NYSMLA matches advertised in the "*Group Tightner*" and open to any qualified person.
- The twenty-five yard target will be the standard "BUF-3" or a target with equal scoring dimensions. For greater ranges, target with score rings consistent with a cone whose apex and score rings are consistent with the dimensions subscribed by the: BUF-3" target shot at 25 yards. Five shot maximum on paper.

METALLIC CARTRIDGE CONDITIONS OF AWARD:

- 1) The club will be an affiliated club of the NYSMLA.
- 2) The score of fifty will be shot using a metallic cartridge rifle with iron sights therefore no telescopic or similar sights and shot in the off-hand position as described by the National Muzzle Loading Association.
- 3) The following targets will be shot in Affiliated Clubs or NYSMLA matches advertised in the "*Group Tightner*" and open to any qualified person. A 2 bull buffalo target B-50 at 100 yards off hand, 5 shots only 3/2.

- D) Distance at which the target was posted

- F) Signature of Club Officer
